# About giving and offerings at C3 Tamworth

We are so excited that you have decided to make C3 Church your spiritual home. Welcome to our local church family.

We have produced these videos to explain what we believe and practice around giving, the tithe and offerings. (We acknowledge that the body of Christ is very diverse and beliefs and practices vary widely. So this is what we do).

## Video #1. Why we bring offerings to God.

Why we bring offerings to God.

 Because the Bible instructs us. Bringing tithes and offerings to God is both an old and new testament practice. We see giving as an act of obedience to God and His Word. Gen 14.20 / Gen 14.22 / Mal 3.10-12 /

• Because it is a part of our worship of God. It is a sacred act of worship where our hearts are filled with praise and thanks for everything God is and does.

Explanation: There are 2 main areas of giving. Malachi 3.8b

1 The tithe. Lev 27.30,32 / Luke 11.42 / Matt 22.21 The *tithe* means a tenth. This is the Biblical *principle* of 'firstfruits'; to set aside the *first portion* of our increase to give to God. Gen 4.4 / Prov 3.9 /

2. Other offerings and giving

Other giving and offerings are 'free-will' (Lev 22.21) and as led by the Holy Spirit. For example: Giving for missions, church facilities, giving to the poor, etc 2 Cor 8.12 / 2 Cor 9.5

- Because it activates our faith. As we release giving, it activates the Kingdom principle of giving and receiving / sowing and reaping. (Gal 6.6-10)
   The Bible teaches that there are many blessings and benefits of bringing offerings to God, and of being generous in general in our lives. Luke 6.38 Generosity is one of our values.
- Because tithes and offerings have always been the primary way that the work of God (the ministry and the mission of the church) is financed. Mal 3.10a / 1 Cor 9.3-14 / 1 Tim 5.17,18
- Because giving ties our hearts to our local church and the work of God in general. In other words, it helps us 'belong'.
   Jesus said "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also". (Matt 6.21)

### We believe:

That being generous is the character and nature of God. John 3.16

That giving is not a legalistic requirement or religious duty, but an opportunity to worship God by being as generous as possible. 2 Cor 9.5-8

That giving should be prayerfully practiced; led, inspired and empowered by the Holy Spirit.

That God can give us grace (His ability, empowerment, divine enablement) to excel in this area of our Christian walk, as in all others. 2 Cor 8.7 / 2 Cor 9.8,14

So may God richly bless you as you embrace the generous life and join with 'team Jesus' as he build His church!

#### Video #2. Practical

There are 3 main areas of where you can give into the ministry and mission of your church.

- The general operating account your tithe should go here
- The building account an opportunity to build facilities for the ministry now and for the future. This is part of our "Kingdom Builders" program.
- The missions account ("Beyond") you can designate a particular area should you desire.
